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**Russia's war against Ukraine and the situation in occupied Abkhazia**

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The separatists, who are now outraged that Russia, represented by the Kremlin leadership, simply occupies a piece of Abkhazia near Pitsunda for summer residences, and argue about "legality" of this, somehow do not remember how "heroes" marauders seized Sukhumi and simply wrote "Occupied" on the doors of houses and flats of Georgians they liked. Often, before doing so they killed the owners of the "trophy" homes.

Did they not realize then that all over Abkhazia, including Pitsunda, they also wrote "Occupied"? It is occupied by Russia. After all, it was Russia that ensured the victory of the separatists, including its regular army, and in fact Russia seized Georgian Abkhazia. They simply did the "rough work" of fratricide and ethnic cleansing. And executioners are always despised. Executors of their brothers, who got their hands on their property, are despised twice.

Russia, by the way, has not yet killed Abkhazians, as their "heroes" and their "war brothers", who today do not want to give up Pitsunda, have killed their Georgian neighbours. Though maybe... Quite Russian-speaking or even ethnic Russian residents of Bucha, Severodonetsk, Mariupol and other Ukrainian cities can confirm this to the Sukhumi separatists.

For many years the separatists themselves received "payment" from the occupants for their work as executioners and traitors. And at that time when the Russian hinterland itself was sitting without money, cash flows were flowing to the separatist Abkhazia on a regular basis and the money was stolen by the separatist "elite". Did the separatists really think that such money was paid to them "just for fun"? And that they would continue to pay them all the time without demanding anything in return?

Now the separatists were made to understand that the Kremlin leadership likes a dacha in Pitsunda and it is taking Pitsunda for itself. And how to explain to Abkhazian population "the need to be grateful to Russia" and "legally formalize" is a problem of the separatist puppets. After all, the Kremlin maintains them and pays a lot of money for their loyalty. If they fail, these puppets will simply be removed, and either other puppets will be appointed. Or simply annex Abkhazia without further ado.

The agreement on the transfer of the territory was signed by the separatist authorities with Moscow on January 19, 2022 but the public of Abkhazia found out only on July 11th. Under this agreement the separatist authorities transferred part of the 184-hectare reserve and the park which includes relic pine forest to the Russian Federation. Experts believe that the agreement was made public out of necessity, since the document must be ratified by the separatist "parliament" for "legitimization". At the same time, the relevant committee of the "parliament" had already voted "in favour", which caused even greater public discontent.

It was the veterans of the separatist war who were particularly outraged by the "illegality" of the transfer. It's strange, even if we assume that those veterans that shed blood during the fratricidal war were not tainted with looting (and there were such cases), why were they not outraged when in 1992-1993 they saw flats and houses of killed and expelled Georgians having "occupied" written on them?

And were not outraged when looters and their "combat brothers" loaded Kamaz trucks with the looted property from Georgian houses. It was "legal" then and not now?

Did they consider it a "legitimate trophy" then? But the separatists have forgotten that it was the same Russian Federation that ensured their "victory" and an opportunity to be robbed, which turns out just "to take its share". The separatists had no idea that in the end the Kremlin's "trophy" was the entire Abkhazia.

One way or another, today the separatist leadership in Sukhumi has to wriggle to justify "legality" of transfer of lands to Russia and at the same time to calm down Abkhazian society. Abkhazian "president" Aslan Bzhania stressed that they were preparing a full-fledged residence in Pitsunda for "big friend of Abkhazia" Russian President Vladimir Putin. He also noted that the famous in Soviet times dacha needs renovation.

But at the same time none of the separatists are specifically unwilling to take responsibility for transferring Pitsunda. They remembered that as an "independent state" they have a certain "Constitutional Court". It was decided to make it "ultimately responsible". In order to then refer to the "constitutional court" to make a decision of the puppet "parliament" on the transfer of Pitsunda.

A corresponding request for compliance of the agreement on the cession of Pitsunda of January 19, 2022 with the separatist "constitution" was sent to the so-called "constitutional court" of the self-proclaimed "republic of Abkhazia". But the so-called "judges" of the so-called "constitutional court", unlike members of the separatist "parliament" and the separatist "government", pretending their "constitutionality" receive relatively small salary and do not participate in writing off the Russian aid. And they simply do not want to take the entire negative of the transfer of Pitsunda upon themselves.

In the end, the "constitutional court" did not accept the Abkhaz parliament's request for verification and "kicked back". No explanation was given by the "constitutional court" as to what exactly the discrepancy was. This "court" simply returned the submitted materials to the "parliament" on the grounds that the parliamentary request "does not meet the requirements of constitutional jurisdiction.

It is clear that sooner or later the Kremlin will force the separatists to "formalize" transfer of Pitsunda, no matter how much the population of Abkhazia resents "illegality" of this act. And perhaps even formalities will not be needed soon if a decision is made to "annex" Abkhazia.

All the more that a similar annexation is already being prepared in respect of the Russian-occupied Kherson and part of the Zaporozhye region of Ukraine. And those dissatisfied with such annexation will simply be destroyed or deported, as it happens with Ukrainians unhappy with the occupation. And even the indignation of the international community can do nothing to help those who are in full power of the occupiers.

Abkhazians are under the same total power of the Russian Federation, occupying Abkhazia. So far, the Kremlin flirts with them, since it is thinking to use the Abkhazian population as "cannon fodder" in the same Ukraine, having previously "voluntarily and officially" received Abkhazian land from the separatist regime. But if the Kremlin fails to do it "voluntarily" it will do it "badly", as it already happened to the Abkhazian people during the Mukhajirstvo. Only de-occupation and reconciliation with a brotherly Georgian people will allow Abkhazians to realize a right to live freely and peacefully in their native land.

An unprecedented statement was made on 29 August 2022 by the so-called "Russian ambassador" to separatist Abkhazia, Mikhail Shargulin. He threatened Abkhazians with withdrawal of the Russian base stationed today in Gudauta, i.e. de facto de-occupation.

Obviously, for the current puppet regime of Sukhumi, it is like death, since the separatist regime relies solely on Russian bayonets, and what is called the "Abkhazian army" is completely ineffective. For the Abkhazian people themselves return to united Georgia will be salvation. The process of their

degradation will finally stop, and peaceful and creative life in a unified state with the brotherly people of Georgia will begin.

Of course, it is clear that Russia is not going to carry out its "threat" of de-occupation of Abkhazia. However, it is important to note the context in which the threat of "ambassador" of the occupying Georgian Abkhazia by the Russian Federation was heard.

On August 29th 2022 "Ambassador" Mikhail Shurgalin met with Abkhazian women at the so-called Russian Embassy in Sukhumi. Details of this meeting were reported by the separatist Nuzhnaya Gazeta. According to this source, the women of Abkhazia said that the majority of the Abkhazian people opposed alienation of the Gosdacha in Pitsunda, since this "contradicts state interests of the country, the constitution and laws of the Republic of Abkhazia".

The women told the ambassador that this agreement causes tensions in society and the women do not want the situation to get out of hand, to have a forceful confrontation between society and the separatist authorities in the country and "...to have anti-Russian sentiments in society...". Particular emphasis was placed on the fact that much of the responsibility for what is happening is on the Abkhazian leadership, which "ignores the laws and the Constitution of Abkhazia".

The women called on the ambassador to use his authority to ensure that the agreement would be canceled as soon as possible. But in response to these statements, the representative of the occupants (i.e. in fact, a full-fledged Russian "governor" of occupied Abkhazia) delivered another ultimatum to the Abkhazian people though "diplomatically", but firmly through the Abkhazian women. Mikhail Shurgalin noted that the issue of alienation of the Goscha is very important for Russia, as it is a "litmus test" paper. He stressed that the government will use this facility as an example to draw conclusions about the possibility of parliament's decision to sell land and real estate to Russians," he said.

" If Parliament ratifies this agreement, for us it will mean that we will be able to deal with issues related to the sale of real estate to Russians," the "ambassador" said.

It turns out that the issue of transfer of lands of Pitsunda to Russia has already been linked with another issue - the sale of Abkhazian land. And at that the issue of Abkhazian land was recently raised by none other than loyal servant of the Armenian lobby Russian State Duma member Konstantin Zatulin.

So it is clear that they decided to "humiliate, degrade and trample" Abkhazians in a complex. By forcing them to give up both Pitsunda (which the Kremlin will take away for summer residences) and land (which will be bought up by Armenian settlers) and statehood (through annexation into the so-called union state with Russia as Caucasus Plus has already written about).

So that the Abkhazians understood that they do not intend to joke with them any more, Mikhail Shurgalin threatened to de-occupy Abkhazia by withdrawal of the military base. That is, he "threatens" that if the occupants and claimants to the Abkhazian land do not get "their" land, the Abkhazians will simply "surrender" to Georgia.

According to Shurgalin, the issue of the Pitsunda state property is very important for the Russian state, and if the dacha is not transferred to Russia, the military base may leave the country, investment programs related to construction of an airport, railway, etc. will be stopped.

In principle, the Russian military base in Gudauta is already "half-empty". Most of its military personnel have been withdrawn from it and thrown into "the Ukrainian front". However, officially no one is going to withdraw the occupation troops from Abkhazia. Another blackmail of the Russian Federation is understandable, but for the Abkhazian society we need to stop giving in to threats and ultimatums of the occupants, not to agree to transfer or sell Abkhazian land to outsiders and start actively seeking ways of reconciliation with the brotherly Georgian people.

The Russian military in separatist Abkhazia will offer to sign a contract, luring young men with large sums of money. Anyone who signs a contract after brief training, or sometimes without it, will

be sent to the front line. The group where Abkhazians will be recruited for the war in Ukraine is called "Storm".

For thousands of Abkhazian families this means one thing - they will receive death certificates after a while and will have to bury their sons, husbands and brothers. If of course, something of them remains in the massacre that was organized by the Kremlin regime in Ukraine.

Recruiters, it seems, are confident in the successful recruitment of "cannon fodder" in the separatist Abkhazia. And there are objective reasons for this.

Almost all experts point out that one of the main problems in Abkhazia is colossal unemployment among Abkhaz youth. The youth environment is rife with criminal mores, drug addiction and alcoholism. As a result young Abkhazians, many of whom have families and small children, are desperately short of money. There is some opportunity to make money during "tourist" season, but as soon as it ends, the problem of lack of money is total in separatist Abkhazia.

The problem is exacerbated by the fact that Abkhazians, intoxicated with nationalist separatist propaganda, consider professions such as janitor or construction worker "undignified and unworthy". After all, they have been instilled that they are "great warriors. And "warriors" consider it "beneath their dignity to pick up a broom. Such work is usually done by migrants from Central Asia. Here arises a paradox: many young Abkhazians seek "prestigious" jobs, are in debt, but do not go for "not prestigious" jobs. It is "prestigious" for Abkhazians to serve in "law enforcement" agencies. But only "friendly" people from the separatist clans are hired there.

Therefore, with no doubt, as soon as they start recruiting "volunteers", or rather mercenaries for the war in Ukraine, thousands of Abkhazians will respond to it. After all, they will be taken for a "dare", as they say, show what kind of "warriors" you are!

Recruiters, recruited for a "salary" of about 200 thousand rubles a month (unthinkable money by Abkhazian standards), are immediately paid an "increased monthly salary" up to 300 thousand rubles, which is the equivalent of about \$ 5 thousand. This will allow many Abkhazians to pay debts and even leave something for their families to live on before going to war.

The fact that once they go to war in Ukraine, they are unlikely to return home, and if they are lucky to return, they will most likely become hopeless cripples and disabled in separatist Abkhazia, is not yet understood by all. After all, society is drugged by the Kremlin propaganda of Simonyan, Skabeeva and Solovyov, according to which only the Ukrainian side bears losses and Russian troops "win" everywhere.

It is known that in the "Storm" group, which is thrown into the most dangerous areas, the payment to the mercenaries is very high. In southern Russia and the North Caucasus, the "Storm" offensive group is promised up to 1.9 million rubles (almost \$30,000!) for their participation in the war, provided they advance one kilometre into Ukraine every day. Except that they do not specify that even in battles without "advancement" the losses are enormous. According to Ukrainian expert Igor Levchenko, usually more than half of the personnel of the aggressors' units are killed every two or three weeks. "Two to three weeks of fighting and the Russian grouping already requires replacement. This tells us that 50-60 percent of the personnel are killed," Levchenko says.

And in the Storm group, 80-90 per cent of the unit often dies after such a "promotion", for which almost 2 million rubles are promised. Hence the constant need for the "Storm" group to update and replenish itself with new "cannon fodder". Moreover, as a rule, those who survive "on the Ukrainian front" are actually professionals with military training. However, for a young man whose military training is limited at best to serving in the so-called "Abkhaz army" to survive in the "Storm" group is almost unrealistic.

Ultimately, the recruitment for the war in Ukraine could turn into the most genuine genocide of the Abkhazian people. All the more that this recruitment will be facilitated by the separatist

authorities in every possible way, since financing of the separatist regime by the Kremlin will depend on the number of recruited "cannon fodder".

Only ending the occupation of Abkhazia, reconciliation and reunification with the brotherly people of Georgia can prevent the threat of a new genocide of the Abkhazian people.

On August 25, 2022 in a live broadcast on the Kremlin propagandist Vladimir Solovyov the puppet separatist "president" Aslan Bzhania actually revealed Russia's plans to completely annex Abkhazia and destroy the fake separatist "statehood". According to him this will be done through the "union state".

Aslan Bzhania said that after the war in Ukraine (which he called "special operation" in the spirit of the Kremlin propaganda) his "republic" was ready to join the so-called "union state of Belarus and Russia". In the context of this "union state" he also mentioned the separatist DNR and LNR in the east of Ukraine, which Russia is also planning to annex.

"The Union State was originally a project for the "beautiful" annexation of Belarus by Russia. But Belarusian leader Alexander Lukashenko resists this process with all his might and the "union state" exists only on paper. For example, Alexander Lukashenko has not yet recognized "independence" of the separatists from Sukhumi and Tskhinvali, being fully aware that this will be the first step towards complete elimination and annexation of his state and thus "equated" with the separatist regimes on the Russian-occupied foreign territories. All the more that at one time Vladimir Putin outlined to the same Lukashenko a prospect of integration of Belarus within the framework of the "union state" into the "six regions" within the Russian Federation.

However, there are new plans in the Kremlin. What it has failed to do with annexation through the "union state" with Belarus, it can do with separatist regimes. At the same time, in this way, it will be possible to nullify the remaining tenuous rights and signs of autonomy of the national republics within the Russian Federation, reducing them to the level of ordinary regions or "provinces".

Actually, instead of a "union state of Russia and Belarus" there can be a "union state of Russia, the DPR, the LPR and Abkhazia. And they can do this without waiting for the war in Ukraine to be over. The separatists will have no more real rights and "independence" here than the Kherson region of Ukraine occupied by Russia today, which is going to be annexed without any "union state". However, what is certain to happen in such a "union state" is a full extension of Russian laws to the annexed territories as well. Including, of course, in the real estate trade.

It is not difficult to guess who is interested in quickly buying up all of Abkhazia's land as part of a "union state". It is no coincidence that on the same day when Bzhania announced annexation of Abkhazia through the "union state" none other than "eternal servant" of the Armenian lobby deputy Konstantin Zatulin, who serves as first deputy chairman of the Duma committee on relations with the CIS, spoke about Abkhazian land. He hurried to please his Armenian friends that it is time "to prepare for purchase of Abkhazia" and mass settlement there. After all, elimination of its "statehood" and all associated restrictions on purchase of real estate was announced by none other than its puppet "president".

In an interview with Gazeta.ru Konstantin Zatulin explained what issues will be resolved by possible inclusion of Abkhazia into the union state.

"I am in favour of this [expansion of the Union State] happening. I think it would create new conditions for a whole range of topical issues. Abkhazia and I have started an Inter-Parliamentary Working Group in which we are trying, for example, to simplify the regime for crossing the Abkhaz-Russian border. And there we cite as an example the regime that exists on the border between Russia and Belarus in the framework of the Union State. And if the desire of Abkhazia to join the Union State is confirmed and it is reformatted, then there will be a green light to resolve the issue this way," Zatulin said.

The MP also conceded that in case of accession of Abkhazia into the "Union State", it would be easier for the parties to agree on the possibility of purchase of "Russians" (it is clear what nationality) land in Abkhazia. However, he is confused by the fact that the resolution of this issue, according to Zatulin, is slowed by "residual fears" in Abkhazian society.

"The opposition in Abkhazia is trying to raise doubts: if this is allowed to happen today, tomorrow Abkhazians will cease to be masters of the country. But it is clear that no one will take the land away from Abkhazia, and this kind of fear hinders development of Abkhazia in practice," Zatulin mockingly noted.

Indeed, no one will take away the land of Abkhazia. That is not why the Kremlin and the Armenian lobby have staged this whole circus "with "independence" of their separatist puppets, and have been feeding them for so many years. They did not need Abkhazians. They needed Abkhazian land. For which there have long been claimants.

There will come to Abkhazian land "new masters" of "the most ancient people", including so beloved by Zatulin Armenian "Artsakh" separatists. The separatists have a maximum of 3 years to stay in the territory of Azerbaijan under the cover of Russian peacekeepers. During this time the separatist Abkhazia will be completely annexed through the "union state".

The Abkhaz themselves are largely being "recycled" in the war in Ukraine. Aslan Bzhania mentioned "heroes" from Abkhazia who died in this war before sharing his plans for a "union state". Well, ethnic Armenians, when the flower of Abkhazian nation is sent to Ukraine for slaughter, are already actively settling there under the guise of an influx of tourists.

Abkhazians in social networks started to be outraged by Zatulin's words. They are posting slogans "Abkhazia is not betrayed. But what can they do? Life and death of Abkhazians are in the hands of the occupants. If they do not spare their own, Russian people on Ukrainian soil, who only have Ukrainian passports, will they really pity people who they see as an annoying "obstacle" in the land they and their Armenian "friends" like?

It seems that the occupants have already decided how they will solve the problem of "ungrateful" Abkhazians who are unhappy with the appropriation of the land of Abkhazia, namely of Pitsunda. They will simply be mobilized in their masses into the armed forces of the Russian Federation and sent "to the slaughter" in Ukraine.

Those who do not agree to such prospects will expect at least 10 years in prison in accordance with amendments to the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation adopted by the Duma "for evading mobilization". Given the prevailing morals in Russian prisons, because of which many prisoners prefer to enlist for combat in Ukraine almost to certain death than to stay in the Russian prison hell, as well as the dislike of the chauvinist propaganda-soaked prison administrations towards "deserters and evaders" - it is almost the same destruction, the same genocide. Only more agonising and "extended in time".

No one is going to "joke" with the population of separatist Abkhazia anymore. Following the announcement of mobilisation by Russian President Vladimir Putin, Secretary of State - Deputy Minister of Defence of the Russian Federation Nikolai Pankov said that Abkhazia would not escape mobilisation.

"Abkhazia will be affected by mobilization, as the population of Abkhazia is almost 100 percent Russian citizens," said Nikolai Pankov, who will oversee mobilization in the separatist "republic". Pankov stressed that there will be no "leniency" towards Abkhazians. On the contrary, they will be "forced to pay debts". And debts, by all appearances, are huge. Was Russia fed and protected the separatists for nothing?! "Russia saved Abkhazians during the war with Georgia and helped them economically to survive and the debt is redeemed" - stressed Deputy Defense Minister of Russia, General of the Army Nikolai Pankov, adding that "criminal responsibility for non-compliance with the order applies to all citizens of the Russian Federation without exception".

General Pankov's words were echoed by the separatist so-called "military commissar" Tarba: "We will not rust. There is no debt to anyone, but we are always there, we are "for", - said the military commissar about the upcoming total mobilization of Abkhazians into the Russian army for the war in Ukraine. Apparently, anticipating fabulous profits from bribes for "exemption from mobilization". But such money to buy off their sons from being sent to certain death in Ukraine (apparently "fabulous") can be found only with a few high-ranking separatist functionaries.

But not all residents of separatist Abkhazia will go to Ukraine to die. In addition to the separatist passport and Russian passport most ethnic Armenians living in Abkhazia have passports of Armenian citizens. And as citizens, albeit citizens of a "union" but another state, most of them will avoid mobilisation.

Abkhazian Armenians can easily cross the border of the Russian Federation with their Armenian passports and travel to the same Armenia to "wait out the war". And then, together with their compatriots from Artsakh and Zangezur they can return to empty Abkhazia where most of the Abkhazian youth will have died in the war in Ukraine by that time.

The irony of fate is that Georgians of the Gali district who are absolutely powerless on the separatist territory will also avoid going to war in Ukraine. Most of them do not have either separatist or Russian citizenship, and they are not subject to mobilization. Of course, the occupants would also "gladly" send them to their slaughter, but they did not and do not want to give Georgians separatist and Russian citizenship on principle. They intend at any convenient occasion to simply expel the remnants of the Georgian population of Abkhazia from their native land. There can be no doubt that this case will be arranged by the "new masters" of Abkhazia from "the most ancient people" who, unlike Abkhazians, are unlikely to die in Ukraine.

Here we have a real "special operation" of selective genocide of the Abkhazian population, during which the entire Abkhazian gene pool will be deliberately thrown "into the furnace" of the Ukrainian war. What to do under such circumstances to Abkhazian families who want to save their sons, husbands and brothers? The only salvation for Abkhazian youth is now in the unoccupied territory of Georgia.

It is still possible to cross the dividing line on the Inguri. There is no doubt that the line of separation will be closed very quickly and Abkhazians who are to be mobilized will be "caught" on it. Then the only chance is to make one's way to the free territory of Georgia by secret paths. They can be advised to Abkhazians by local Georgians. This is the only way for Abkhazians to save their youth from a pointless death in the steppes of Ukraine.

While in Georgia Abkhazians have all rights of citizens of Georgia. They can live in peace, study in Georgian universities, work and wait until their homeland is freed from occupation and reunited with the brotherly Georgian people in a single state.

### Война России против Украины и ситуация в оккупированной Абхазии Резюме

В представленной статье анализируется положение в оккупированной Абхазии в контексте войны России против украинского государства. Руководители абхазских сепаратистов наивно думают, что живут в «независимой стране». Они убеждают собственное население в этом, но реальность другая. Россия призывает оккупированную часть грузинского населения Абхазии принять участие в своей несправедливой войне против украинского народа, против украинского государства! Тех, кто будет не согласен на подобную перспективу ждет как минимум 10 лет тюрьмы, согласно принятым Госдумой РФ поправкам в Уголовный кодекс РФ «за уклонение от мобилизации». Учитывая царящие в российских тюрьмах нравы, из-за которых многие заключенные предпочитают завербоваться воевать в Украине почти на верную смерть, чем находится в российском тюремном аду, а также нелюбовь пропитанных шовинистической пропагандой администрации мест заключения к «дезертирам и уклонистам» – это почти то же самое уничтожение, тот же геноцид. Только более мучительный и «растянутый по времени».

С населением сепаратистской Абхазии «шутить» больше никто не собирается. После объявления мобилизации президентом РФ Владимиром Путиным, статс-секретарь – заместитель министра обороны Российской Федерации Николай Панков заявил, что Абхазия не избежит мобилизации.«Абхазию коснется мобилизация, так как население Абхазии почти на 100% состоит из российских граждан» - заявил Николай Панков, который будет курировать мобилизацию в сепаратистской «республике». Панков подчеркнул, что «снисхождения» к абхазам не будет. Наоборот, их «заставят платить долги». А долги, судя по всему огромные. Даром, что ли РФ столько лет кормила и защищала сепаратистов?! «Россия спасла абхазов во время войны с Грузией и помогла им экономически выжить и долг красен платежом» - подчеркнул зам.министра обороны РФ, генерал армии Николай Панков, добавив, что «уголовная ответственность за невыполнение приказа распространяется на всех граждан РФ без исключения».Подтвердил слова генерала Панкова и сепаратистский т.н. «военный комиссар» Тарба:«За нами не заржавеет. Никаких долгов ни перед кем нет, но мы всегда рядом, мы "за"», – сказал военком о предстоящей тотальной мобилизации абхазов в российскую армию для войны в Украине. По-видимому, предвкушая баснословные доходы от взяток за «освобождение от мобилизации». Но такие деньги, чтобы откупить сыновей от отправки на верную гибель в Украину (судя по всему «бешенные»), могут найтись лишь у единиц высокопоставленных сепаратистских функционеров. Но поедут умирать на войну в Украину

не все жители сепаратистской Абхазии. У большинства проживающих в Абхазии этнических армян помимо сепаратистского и российского паспортов, есть еще и паспорта граждан Армении. И как граждане пусть и «союзного», но другого государства, большинство из них избегают мобилизации.

Абхазские армяне могут без проблем также по своим армянским паспортам пересекать границы РФ и выезжать в ту же Армению, чтобы «пересидеть войну». А затем вместе с соплеменниками из «арцах» и Зангезура вернуться заселять опустевшую Абхазию, где большая часть абхазской молодежи к тому времени погибнет на войне в Украине. Ирония судьбы также заключается в том, что отправки на войну в Украину избегают абсолютно бесправные на сепаратистской территории грузины Гальского района. Они в большинстве своем не имеют ни сепаратистского, ни российского гражданства и мобилизации не подлежат. Безусловно, оккупанты тоже бы «с удовольствием» отправили их на убой, но принципиально не хотели и не хотят давать грузинам сепаратистского и российского гражданства, намереваясь при любом удобном случае просто изгнать остатки грузинского населения Абхазии с родной земли. То, что этот случай устроят «новые хозяева» Абхазии из «древнейшего народа», которые в отличие от абхазов гибнуть в Украине вряд ли будут, можно не сомневаться. Налицо настоящая «спецоперация» по избирательному геноциду населения Абхазию, в ходе которого будет специально брошен «в топку» украинской войны весь абхазский генофонд. Что делать в таких условиях абхазским семьям, которые хотят спасти своих сыновей, мужей и братьев? Единственное спасение для абхазской молодежи сейчас на неоккупированной территории Грузии. Пока еще линию разделения по Ингури можно перейти. Нет сомнения, что линию разделения очень быстро «перекроют» и будут «отлавливать» на ней абхазов, подлежащих мобилизации. Тогда единственный шанс – пробираться на свободную территории Грузии тайными тропами. Их могут подсказать абхазам местные грузины. Лишь таким образом абхазы могут спасти свою молодежь от бессмысленной гибели в степях Украины.

В Грузии же абхазы имеют все права граждан Грузии. Они могут спокойно жить, учиться в грузинских ВУЗах, работать и дожидаться, когда их родная земля будет освобождена от оккупации и воссоединиться в рамках единого с братским грузинским народом государства.

В сепаратистской Абхазии российские военные будут предлагать подписать контракт, заманивая молодых людей крупными суммами денег. Все, кто подпишет контракт после кратковременной подготовки, а иногда и без нее, будут отправлены на передовую. Группа, куда абхазов будут вербовать на войну в Украину, называется «Шторм». Для тысяч абхазских семей это означает одно – они спустя некоторое время получат похоронки и будут вынуждены хоронить своих сыновей, мужей и братьев. Если конечно от них что-то в той бойне, которую организовал кремлевский режим в Украине, останется. Вербовщики, судя по всему, уверены в успешном наборе «пушечного мяса» в сепаратистской Абхазии. И тому есть объективные причины. Практически все эксперты отмечают, что одна из главных проблем Абхазии — это колоссальная безработица среди абхазской молодежи. В молодежной среде распространены уголовные нравы, наркомания, алкоголизм. Как результат, молодым абхазам у многих из которых семьи и маленькие дети катастрофически не хватает

денег, большая часть молодых людей «завязли» в долгах. Кое-какая возможность заработать есть в «туристический» сезон, но как только он заканчивается, так проблема безденежья становится в сепаратистской Абхазии тотальной. Проблема усугубляется тем, что одурманенные националистической сепаратистской пропагандой абхазы считают профессии вроде дворника или строителя «непрестижными и недостойными». Ведь им внушали, что они «великие воины». А «воины» считают «ниже своего достоинства брать в руки метлу. Такую работу, как правило, выполняют мигранты из Центральной Азии. Возникает парадокс: масса молодых абхазов ищут «престижного» заработка, погрязли в долгах, но не идут на «не престижную» работу. «Престижно» для абхаза служить в «силовых» структурах, в тех же правоохранительных органах. Но туда берут только «своих» из правящих сепаратистских кланов.

Поэтому нет никакого сомнения, что как только в Абхазии начнется набор «добровольцев», а точнее наемников на войну в Украину, то на него откликнутся тысячи абхазов. Ведь их будут брать «на слабо», мол, покажите, какие вы «воины»! Вербовщики завербованным на «зарплату» около 200 тыс. рублей в месяц (немыслимые деньги по абхазским меркам), сразу выплачивают «повышенный месячный оклад», до 300 тысяч рублей, что в эквиваленте около 5 тысяч долларов. Это многим абхазам позволит рассчитаться с долгами и даже кое-что оставить на жизнь семье перед тем, как отправится на войну. То, что, попав на войну в Украину, они вряд ли домой вернуться, а если посчастливится вернуться то, скорее всего безнадежными калеками и инвалидами в сепаратистской Абхазии, пока что не все понимают. Ведь общество одурманено кремлевской пропагандой Симоньян, Скабеевой и Соловьева, согласно которой потери несет только украинская сторона, а российские войска везде «побеждают».

Известно, что в группе «Шторм», которую бросают на самые опасные участки, оплата наемникам очень высокая. На юге России и Северном Кавказе за участие в войне в наступательном отряде "Шторм" обещают до 1,9 миллиона рублей (почти 30 тыс. долларов!), при условии ежедневного продвижения по территории Украины на один километр. Вот только там не уточняют, что даже в боях без «продвижения» потери огромны. По словам украинского эксперта Игоря Левченко, обычно гибнет свыше половины личного состава подразделений агрессоров за каждые две-три недели. «Две-три недели боев и российская группировка уже требует замены. Это говорит, что 50–60 процентов личного состава гибнет», – говорит Левченко.

А в составе группы «Шторм» после такого «продвижения», за которое обещаны почти 2 млн. рублей, часто гибнет 80-90% подразделения. Отсюда постоянная потребность группы «Шторм» в обновлении и пополнении новым «пушечным мясом». Причем выживают «на украинском фронте» как правило, действительно профессионалы, имеющие военную подготовку. Однако выжить в группе «Шторм» молодому человеку, чья военная подготовка исчерпывается в лучшем случае службой в так называемой «абхазкой армии» почти нереально. В итоге, вербовка на войну в Украину может обернуться самым настоящим геноцидом абхазского народа. Тем более, что этой вербовке всячески будут способствовать сепаратистские власти, ведь от количества завербованного «пушечного мяса» будет зависеть финансирование сепаратистского режима Кремлем. Предотвратить угрозу нового геноцида абхазского народа может лишь будет лишь прекращение оккупацию Абхазии, примирение и воссоединившись с братским грузинским народом.
